SCHOOL FEES & PAYMENT SCHEDULES

Student bills were made available last year on the final day of term.

For Day students, the payment plan is as follows for those who are unable to fully pay at the beginning of the term:

DUE	Due Date	Instalment
50%	Tuesday, January 9, 2024	1st
25%	Monday, February 5, 2024	2nd
25%	Monday, March 4, 2024	3rd

The 3rd instalment is the final instalment of fees and parents must ensure that by then their ward's fees have been settled in full.

UTILITY BILLS

We would like to inform parents that we have had to top up the bill for utilities included in students' school fees. As such the newly adjusted fees for utilities are as follows: Boarders – GHS200; Day students – GHS100.

Our meters were recently changed and consumption has been outrageously overwhelming. Our water supply comes from our borehole which also uses electricity and therefore adds to our high utility bill.



EVENING SCHOOL

Evening School is highly necessary for Junior High 2 and 3 students especially. We have some external teachers who support us with their expertise as examiners.

We encourage parents to enrol their wards for Evening School.

For Day students, this is at a monthly cost of GH¢ 150.00

and includes feeding fee for Supper.

It will run from 5pm to 7pm.



HYGIENE PROTOCOLS AND SAFETY MEASURES

We would like to encourage parents to do their best to ensure that their wards diligently adhere to safety and hygiene protocols. Students should mask up on account of the reported new variants of Covid-19, as well as the weather and dust. On arrival at the school every morning, all are expected to wash their hands at the hand-washing station at the gate.

Kindly provide your ward with hand sanitizer.

Parents who are able to support the school with gifts of Thermometer guns, Veronica buckets and Sanitizer or Soap dispensers are still welcome to do so.

These would be greatly appreciated.



PARENTS' ROLE AND COMMITMENT

We would ask that parents and guardians take an active role in the supervision of their children's work to ensure that their academic work is at optimum level.
