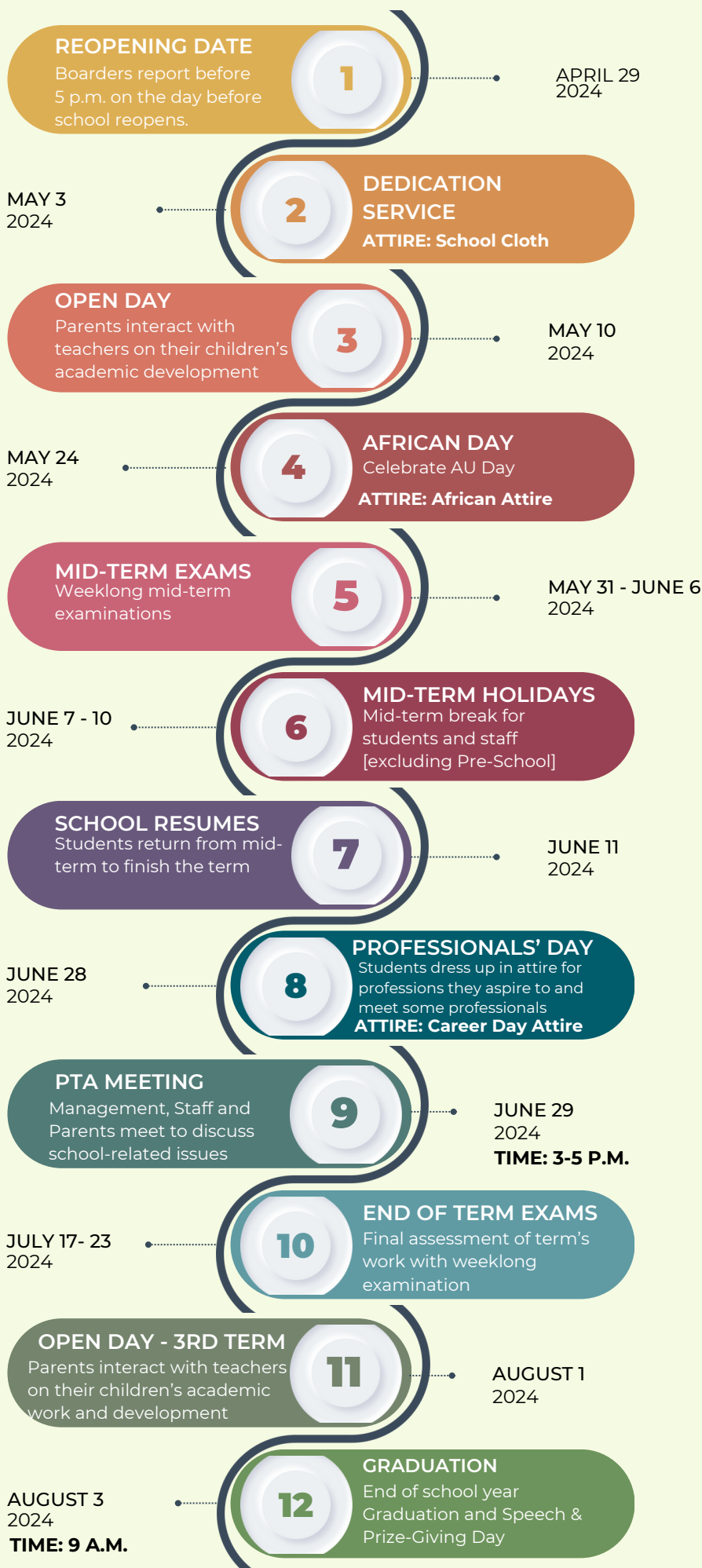

## SCHOOL FEES & PAYMENT SCHEDULES

Student bills were made available last year on the final day of term.

**For Day students,** the payment plan is as follows for those who are unable to fully pay at the beginning of the term:

DUE	Due Date	Instalment
50%	Monday, April 29, 2024	1st
25%	Monday, June 3, 2024	2nd
25%	Monday, July 1, 2024	3rd

The 3rd instalment is the final instalment of fees and parents must ensure that by then their ward's fees have been settled in full.

**For boarders**, the payment plan is as follows for those who are unable to fully pay at the beginning of the term:

It will run from 5pm to 7pm.



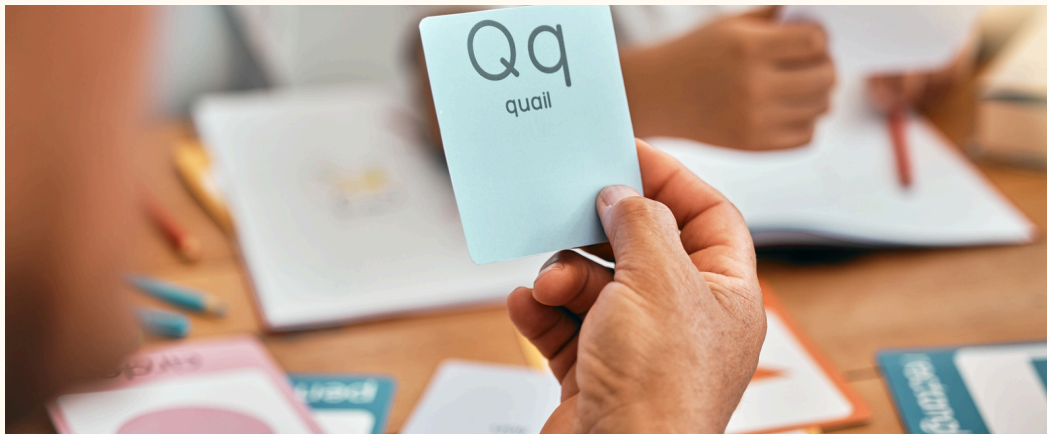
## HYGIENE PROTOCOLS AND SAFETY MEASURES
